LTC 501 is also a pre-requisite for all three levels of NIAAA Certification including Registered Athletic Administrator (new) Certified Athletic Administrator, and Certified Master of Athletic Administration (new)

Completing both courses (501 & 504) doubles NIAAA Liability Insurance coverage from \$1M to \$2M dollars.

There will be no walk-in registration. Anyone taking the course **MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED** by September 15th – **NO LATE REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED**
